



Chemin du Roy

This map illustrates the Chemin du Roy route, a historic path connecting Montreal to Lévis. The route is highlighted in orange and follows the St. Lawrence River (Fleuve Saint-Laurent) and Lac Saint-Pierre. Key regions shown include Lanaudière, Mauricie, Centre-du-Québec, Chaudière-Appalaches, and Montérégie.
